- e. Consider "Fra Lippo Lippi" as a successful example of dramatic monologue.
- f. Browning's dramatic monologues are soul-studies. Illustrate the view with reference to "Andrea del Sarto".
- g. Comment on Keats' positive approach to melancholy in "Ode on Melancholy".
- h. Discuss how Keats' "Ode to Psyche" is a poem on the working of poetic imagination.
